Senior Savings Tip:

Apply for our Special Senior Exemptions.

Are you 65 years of age or older? If the answer is yes, you might be eligible for exemptions that will save you money. If you are married, only one person whose name is on the deed needs to meet the age requirement.

Homestead Exemptions:

- **Senior School Tax Exemption, known as the L5A:** provides total exemption from taxes levied by the Gwinnett County Board of Education on a home and up to one acre of property located within the Gwinnett County School District. You must reside in a home that you own and meet the annual income limit. The 2025 income limit is \$121,432. Your income will be verified by line 15C of your 2023 or 2024 Georgia income tax return. Documentation is required.

Are you 62 or older?

- **Regular School Tax Exemption, known as the S3:** provides a partial exemption from school taxes. The income limit is \$10,000 a year. Documentation is required.



Senior Emissions Waiver:

Are you 65 years of age or older and own a car that is at least 10 years old? The Senior Emissions Waiver eliminates the emissions test for tag renewal if you drive 5,000 miles or less annually. We can complete your emissions waiver over the phone (770-822-8818) or in a tag office.

GET YOUR DECAL INSTANTLY AT A KIOSK



Kiosks are a convenient way to renew your tag. All you need is your driver's license and debit or credit card to get your decal instantly. Convenience fees apply and one fee covers up to 10 vehicles. You can renew your vehicle up to 60 days before your birthday. Kiosks are located across the county and metro area. Many are located in Kroger and Publix stores. Some are multipurpose and allow you to renew your driver's license or ID card, a service provided by the Georgia Department of Driver Services, or DDS. SAVINGS FOR SENIOR GWINNETT HOMEOWNERS

Did you know that Gwinnett County provides a 25 percent solid waste fee discount to homeowners who are 62 years of age or older?

The discount is applied to the primary residence and will remain in effect until the home is sold. Proof of your identity, address, and age and a notarized affidavit of homeownership are required.

Visit the Solid Waste Management website and complete the application form to take advantage of your 25% discount on solid waste services. You can submit your application:
