Purpose of this form: This form is to be used to provide evidence that a transaction between the purchaser(s)/transferee(s) and seller(s)/transferor(s) has taken place and that the odometer reading has been declared by the vehicle's seller(s) and acknowledged by the vehicle's buyer(s).

Completing this form: This form must be completed in its entirety, legibly printed or typed.

Section A: Record the vehicle's information. Please note: Federal regulations require the seller(s)/transferor(s) to disclose the odometer reading and the purchaser(s)/transferee(s) to acknowledge the odometer reading upon the transfer of ownership of a vehicle that is not exempt from odometer disclosure requirements.

Section B: Complete the seller(s)/transferor(s) information. If a court has ordered the sale of the vehicle, record the court's case number. If the seller/transferor is a business, provide Georgia Tax Identification Number and Georgia Sales Tax Number.

Section C: Provide the purchaser(s)/transferee(s) information.

Section D: Record, if any, lienholders, security interest holders or encumbrance holders.

Section E: Certify all statements are true and accurate.

How to submit this form: Submit this form along with required documents and applicable tax to the county tag office in the county where the primary purchaser resides. Please refer to https://mvd.dor.ga.gov/motor/tagoffices/selecttagoffice.aspx to locate the county tag office in the primary purchaser's county of residence.

Required documents: A court order is required if a court has ordered the sale of the vehicle. A Georgia certificate of title is required if the vehicle being sold/transferred is a 1986 or newer model year motor vehicle, motorcycle, camper, travel trailer, or car/tow dolly weighing 2,001 pounds or more; or a 1963 or newer model year mobile home.

Applicable tax: If the vehicle requires a title, go to https://dor.georgia.gov/drives-e-services and click on the Title Ad Valorem Tax Estimator link to get an estimated Title Ad Valorem Tax (TAVT) amount based on the value of the vehicle. Note: Trailers are not subject to TAVT.

Form sections: A VEHICLE INFORMATION, B SELLER(S) / TRANSFEROR(S) INFORMATION, C PURCHASER(S) / TRANSFEE(S) INFORMATION, D LIENHOLDER OR SECURITY INTEREST HOLDER INFORMATION, E CERTIFICATION. Includes fields for VIN, Year, Make, Model, Odometer Reading, Date of Sale/Transfer, Purchase Price, Court Order Case No., Georgia Tax ID No., Georgia Sales Tax No., Seller(s)/Transferor(s) Full Legal Name(s), Mailing Address, City, State, ZIP Code, County, Purchaser(s)/Transferee(s) Full Legal Name(s), Mailing Address, City, State, ZIP Code, County, Lienholder's or Security Interest Holder's Name, Mailing Address, City, State, ZIP Code, Telephone No., and Signature(s) for Seller(s)/Transferor(s) and Buyer(s)/Transferee(s).
